

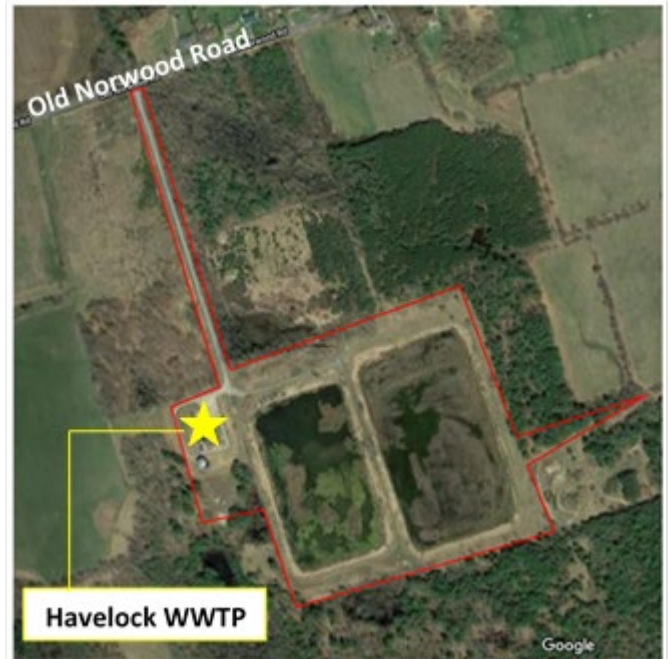


Notice of Study Commencement

Havelock Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) Class Environmental Assessment

What is this study about?

The Township of Havelock-Belmont-Methuen is initiating a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study to plan for additional sanitary sewage capacity to service the Village of Havelock. Additional capacity is required to support growth forecasts to 2041 and beyond. The existing Havelock WWTP (719 Old Norwood Road, Havelock) which services the community, is nearing its rated capacity and may not be able to accommodate additional sanitary flows for planned development. The study will identify and evaluate alternative approaches for providing additional capacity at the Havelock WWTP. The preferred approach will be selected to minimize technical, community, natural environmental and economic impacts.



How is this study being done?

The study will be carried out in accordance with the requirements of Schedule C projects as defined in the Municipal Class EA planning process (October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011, and 2015), which is an approved process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.

How can I participate in this study?

Public consultation is an integral component of this project. Public meetings will be held to present project information, preliminary results of the decision-making process, and to provide opportunity for feedback to the project team. Project notices will be issued in advance to provide detailed information of the public meetings.
