



## Application for Notice to Engage in an Activity in a Vulnerable Area for a Municipal Drinking Water Supply

Under Part IV of the Clean Water Act, 2006, Regulation of Drinking Water Threats

Under the *Clean Water Act* (*Act*), a drinking water threat is "an activity or condition that adversely affects or has the potential to adversely affect the quality or quantity of any water that is or may be used as a source of drinking water". The *Act* lists the activities that are a drinking water threat, if undertaken in select areas and under certain circumstances.

The Risk Management Official for the Otonabee-Peterborough Source Protection Area will review this Application to determine if any associated activities (existing or proposed) may represent a significant threat to the source of a municipal drinking water supply and if any policy(s) contained in the Trent Source Protection Plan (SPP) apply to the activity(s). The SPP contains policies intended to manage drinking water threat activities and protect municipal drinking water sources.

By Agreement, the Otonabee Region Conservation Authority, acting under its authority as the Otonabee-Peterborough Source Protection Authority, is acting as an Agent of the following municipalities for the duties and enforcement responsibilities under Part IV of the *Act*, the Regulation of Drinking Water Threats, for the lands located in the Municipalities of Asphodel-Norwood, Cavan Monaghan, Douro-Dummer, Otonabee-South Monaghan, Selwyn, Trent Lakes and the City of Peterborough.

- Notices or Letters issued under Section 59 of the Clean Water Act by the Otonabee Region Conservation Authority (ORCA) are non-transferable and valid for a period of five years from the date of issuance.
- Permits, approvals, etc. may be required from other agencies prior to undertaking any activities that may be associated with this Application.
- The issuance of a Notice upon review of this Application does not exempt the owner/applicant from complying with any or all other applicable laws, statutes, ordinances, directives, regulations, approvals, etc. as they may relate to the activities carried out on the Subject Property.
- If information provided on or with this Application is determined to be untrue or incorrect, or becomes untrue or incorrect, ORCA reserves the right to nullify any prior decisions and issuances based on review of this Application.
- If the Applicant is not the owner of the Subject Property, a copy of the Notice or Letter issued as it relates to this Application, the Applicant may be required to provide a copy of said Notice of Letter to the owner.
- Additional information may be required to process this Application, the costs of which will be borne by the Applicant.
- Once submitted, all non-personal information related to this Application becomes the property of ORCA and may be used by ORCA, its' member municipalities and partners.
- Members of the public may view studies, plans, reports and issuances related to this Application by submitting a
  formal request under the Municipal Freedom of Information Protection and Privacy Act, RSO 1990, c. M. 56. Access
  is subject to statutory exemptions.
- Insufficient information may delay the processing of this Application.
- The Risk Management Official may enter the Subject Property which is the subject of this Application for the purpose of obtaining information and monitoring any approved works as authorized under the *Act*.
